

How to Use the Route Maps and Schedules

The route maps and schedules are color coordinated. The numbered stops on the map match the numbered locations listed on the schedule. To determine what time a bus will stop at a specific location, read across. To determine how long it will take you to get from one location to another, read down. Transfer points indicate designated stops at which you may transfer to other routes. When transferring, check the schedule of the route you are transferring to for exact times and return trip availability.

Bus and Trolley Fares

Full Fare, 1-Ride	\$1.25
Reduced Fare, 1-Ride	\$.60
Full Fare, 10-Ride Pass	\$10.00
Reduced Fare, 10-Ride Pass	\$5.00
Full Fare, Unlimited Monthly Pass	\$35.00
Reduced Fare, Unlimited Monthly Pass	\$17.00

Those eligible for **Reduced Fare** include seniors (60+), disabled, veterans, and students. BCC students ride for free with a valid BCC student ID. Medicare cards are accepted as proof for reduced fare. There is no charge for children under the age of five, or for transfers. Due to a grant from the City of Melbourne, no fare is charged on routes 1 and 21 to Melbourne residents who ride within the Melbourne city limits.

A **10-Ride Pass** and **Monthly Pass** fare specials must be purchased in advance at either of the Space Coast Area Transit bus terminals, by mail, by phone, or at select Brevard County Libraries.

- The bus terminals are located at 401 South Varr Ave., Cocoa, Florida 32922, and 460 South Harbor City Blvd., Melbourne, Florida 32901.
- Credit card purchases may be made over the phone by calling 635-7815 x 403 or 604.
- Checks, money orders and credit card orders are accepted by mail.

The following holidays are generally observed: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day, the day after Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, and Christmas Day.

Helpful Hints for Using Space Coast Area Transit

- **The safety of our passengers is our #1 priority.**
- Please limit packages to those you can personally carry on the bus by yourself.
- Be at the stop at least 5 minutes prior to the scheduled arrival time.
- Do not approach a moving bus.
- If you need assistance to board the bus, please ask. It is part of the driver's duty to help.
- Have exact fare, ticket or pass ready prior to boarding the bus. Drivers cannot make change.
- Transfers are issued for transfer points only.
- Leave seats near the front for elderly or disabled riders, moving promptly to the next available seat.
- Passengers may only use audio devices with head phones activated.
- Eating, drinking, smoking, or any materials that are flammable are not allowed on buses.
- Service animals are the only animals allowed.
- If available, use the stop bar or pull cord to signal your stop one block in advance. If one is not available, alert your driver at least one block in advance.
- Do not leave your seat until the bus is fully stopped.
- All buses are equipped with bike racks. Surfboards and bikes are permitted inside the bus when space is available.
- Proper attire is needed to board. Shirts and shoes are required. Bathing suits, except board shorts, must be covered.
- **All scheduled times are approximate and depend on traffic and other conditions.**

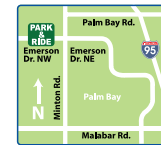

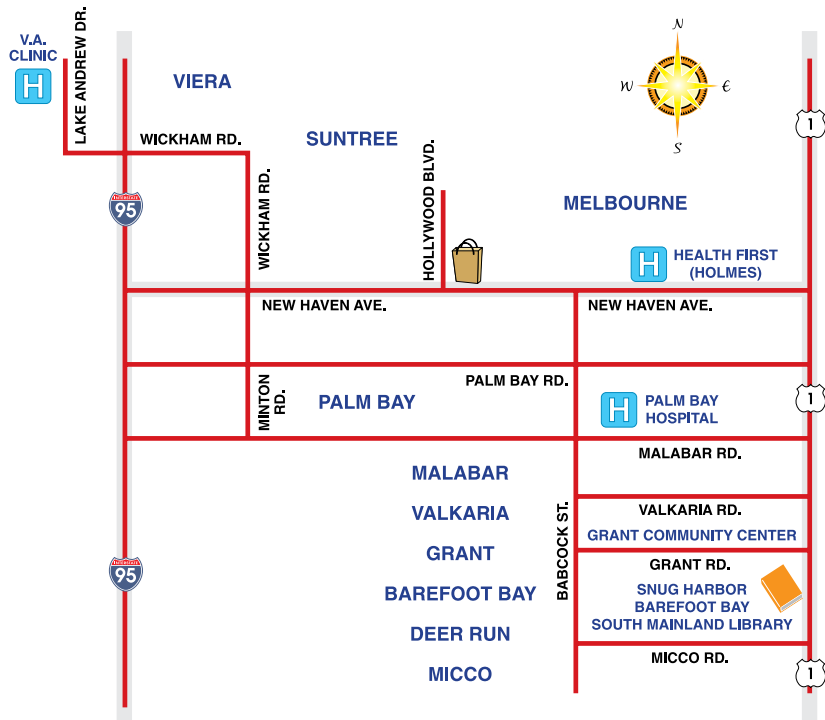

Dial-A-Bus will operate from Valkaria Road and the greater Micco community. The bus will pick up customers at specific points, and for those that need a home pick up, the wheelchair equipped bus will also be available. Destinations will be as far North as the Viera Complex and as far South as the Sebastian Super Wal-Mart area. The hours of operation will be from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Please call for reservations for pick up. For a home pick up you must call before 2:00 p.m. the day before your trip.

Route 32 is a Dial-A-Bus Service that has Para-Transit fares of \$2.50 for Full Fare and \$1.25 for Elderly, Disabled, Students and Veterans. This special bus is operated out of Barefoot Bay.
